Physical Injury – Getting hit with racket or ball	Collision of two players, “Wild” Play	Referees + tournament controllers to warn of dangerous play	Squash Rackets/Balls	Tournament controllers, school managers
Sick/worn out children	Over exertion during matches/bad nutrition	First aid and nutritious food available on site	First Aid	Individuals, school managers/coaches
Physical injury outside of court, within the club area	Running up/down stairs, jumping over barriers, swinging rackets around club area	No running while outside the court; team managers to monitor dangerous behaviour while off the court		Team managers/coaches
Slipping on court	Incorrect shoes/clothing worn	Team coaches and tournament coordinators to ensure correct squash attire is worn	Court shoes, dry fit clothing	Team Manager/Coach; Tournament Controller
Getting hit in the eye	Not wearing correct eyewear	Tournament controllers will not allow play if incorrect eyewear is worn	WSF approved eyewear	Team Manager/Coach; Tournament Controller
