

# **Auckland Junior Volleyball Championships**

# Tournament Information Wednesday 16th – Friday 18<sup>th</sup> November 2022

#### Venue

Pulman Park, Takanini

### **Entry Qualification**

This tournament is open to any teams from schools within the area administered by College Sport Auckland.

 Any teams who default on finals day put their school in jeopardy of participating in this event next year and a fine will be issued of \$200.

To be confirmed in the championship, each team must complete the following by the team list closing date:

- Compulsory meeting for all Coaches and Managers for all participating teams on Monday 14 November at 7.00pm.
- Students ID need to be sent to margaret@collegesport.co.nz by the 9 November
- Nominate their qualified referee, endorsed (as competent) by the appropriate volleyball association or zone coordinator.
- Ist referees will be supplied, note you will still need to provided a scorer, 2<sup>nd</sup> referee and one line referee for all of your own games
- Nominate a school staff member or other responsible adult to supervise the team at all times.
- Schools will be invoiced after their team entries have closed
- Please note that teams withdrawn after the entry closing date will still be liable for the entry fee.
- Entries will not be accepted from schools with outstanding Volleyball debts, unless payment of these debts is made by the entry closing date.

#### **Entry Date**

- Online entries will close 3 November at 11.59pm
- Complete the team list online by 9 November 2022, 11.59pm

**Note:** The top 9 Junior Premier League teams will be seeded 1-9 for the championships.

#### **First Aid**

· All teams to bring their own first aid kits

#### **Playing Format**

- Each match will be best-of-three sets (sets to 25 and deciding set of 15, each with a minimum 2-point advantage)
- Roll-On, Roll-Off will be used to keep matches on schedule. Between each match there will be a maximum of 10 minutes' duration from the time the preceding match ends to the first serve

of the subsequent match.

However, court controllers may use their discretion to decide appropriate intervals in extraordinary cases, with consultation with the tournament director.

#### **Tournament Rules**

All rules included in the FIVB Official Volleyball Rules 2021-2024 will be in use with the exception of:

- 12 substitutions instead of 6 per set.
- NO libero player will be used in this junior competition.

Please note, team uniforms must be of uniform style and colour. Playing shirts must be numbered on both the front and back. Teams risk forfeiting matches for incorrect uniform.

## **Player Eligibility**

Players must meet these criteria as determined by VNZ for this Junior competition. These are that they must be:

- Junior Grade Year 9 or Year 10 only
- Student Photo ID is required

A maximum of 12 players may be registered in one team. Registration must be put into the system when entering online.

Please note that players may be replaced in your official team registration up until the coaches meeting prior to the tournament. After this time, no players may be added.
