

# **Competition Rules and Regulations**

## Playing Rules of the game

- All matches will be played according to the rules of FIVB.
- Junior teams may not use a Libero and may make 12 substitutions
- Seeding for the North Island Championship will come from the College Sport Volleyball Championships held each year.

#### Eligibility

- Junior team players Year 9 or Year 10 only.
- Senior team players must be under 19 on 1 January of the current year.

#### **Time of Games**

- As per your zone draws
- Best of 3 sets for Junior & Senior competition with each set 25, 25, 15.
- All teams must provide one referee for their own match
- A team will be considered to be in default should they not field a team within the first ten minute period of the game at a venue or 15 minute period home and away games. If you turn up within this period games may be shortened to accommodate times on the draw.

## **Competition Format**

Sections will play a round robin competition followed by section playoffs (if required) as per your zone

#### Results

- All results are to be entered on-line
- It is the school's responsibility to check weekly, the accuracy of results on the website www.collegesport.co.nz (please allow 2 days after game day for processing to occur).
- Corrections to results will not be accepted within 4 days of a final.
- Points: Win = 2 Loss = 0 Default = -2. A count back on sets will determine a winner in the event of tied points and games.
- Senior Premier best of 5 sets, Junior Premier best of 3 sets
- All Premier results submitted must be in the format of points per set for the number of sets played.
  e.g. 25-17, 25-23, 15-12

#### **Uniforms**

- All players must play in the school's recognised playing uniform.
- All uniforms must have a number on the front and back of Shirt. This is for Senior and Junior competitions.

# **Team Management**

• Ensure there is a school approved adult in charge of each team for the entirety of the game. If a team does not have supervision, they will lose by default. Supervisors should identify each other at the start of the game.

# Officiating/Duties

All teams have responsibility for duties and points may be deducted for not completing these duties.

#### **Rescheduling & Defaults**

 Please check the College Sport Rules concerning defaults and rescheduling either via our website or in the College Sport diary.

# **Disputes Resolution**

- In all cases, if your team has a concern or disagreement with the opposition, this should be resolved on a school-to-school basis. Any necessary correspondence thereafter should be precise, but polite. A copy of your letter can be sent to College Sport for their information.
- If a satisfactory result is not achieved between the two parties, the dispute can be directed to College Sport.

## First Aid

• Each team is responsible for their own first aid. The coach/manager should be aware of any special medical conditions of a player.
