- A separate entry is required for the Term 3 competition for all Grades

Team Management

All teams must have a teacher or adult with them at every game. This person is to check the score sheet before and after the game where needed, be aware of any medical problems of players in the team, implement the rules of the competition, and supervise the players. Teams without supervision may lose by default. Please make all students aware of the "non-marking soft soled shoes" and "No Food & Drink Policy" in the playing area.

Rules

All teams are to consist of a minimum of 3 players and a maximum of 5 players (only 3 play each night) and can have either all male, all female or mixed. In each contest three players will play two singles each, and two players from each team will combine to play one doubles. All teams must supply their own balls. Balls can be purchased from the Waitemata Table Tennis Association for \$2.00 per ball.

The Waitemata Table Tennis Association will apply the laws and regulations of table tennis as sanctioned by TTNZ, ITTF and played under CSA bylaws.

Uniforms

School sports uniform including non-marking soft sole shoes, to be worn at all times. Any player not wearing the correct clothing and footwear can have their game defaulted.
