Team Management

All teams must have a teacher or adult with them at every game. This person is to complete the score sheet before and after the game where needed, be aware of any medical problems of players in the team, implement the rules of the competition, and supervise the players. Teams without supervision may lose by default.

Rules

All teams are to consist of a minimum of 3 players and a maximum of 5 players (only 3 play each night) and can have either all male, all female or mixed. In each contest three players will play two

singles each, and two players from each team will combine to play one doubles. All teams must supply their own balls. Balls can be purchased from the Auckland Table Tennis Stadium for \$2.00 per ball.

The Auckland Table Tennis Association will apply the laws and regulations of table tennis as sanctioned by TTNZ, ITTF and played under CSA bylaws.

Uniforms

A reasonable standard of dress, including non-marking soft soled shoes, should be worn at all times
