

Archery Match Play Championships Entry & Competition Information 2024

Date

Sunday 7 April 2024 – rain or shine

Venue

Auckland Archery Club, One Tree Hill Domain

Entries

- Entries must be submitted in <u>EnterNOW</u> by 11.59pm Wednesday 27th March 2024.
- College Sport Auckland will invoice schools after the entries closing date.
- Archers withdrawn after the entries closing date will still be liable for the entry fee.

Divisions

- Recurve (Individuals & Teams)
- NEW: Barebow (Individuals & Teams)
- Compound (Individuals & Teams)

Other than these categories, there shall be no age or gender classification.

Time:

8.00am Arrival time followed by bow inspection

8.40am Welcome and Briefing

8.45am Qualification round starts – this may run in two sessions depending on numbers

After the qualification round, we will then begin the Individual Matchplay events followed by the Team events. Times will vary depending on entry numbers.

Rounds

Qualification Round:

- Recurve and Barebow/Longbow 30 arrows @ 25m, 80cm target face
- Compound 30 arrows @ 25m, 40cm target face
- One 6-arrow sighting end
- All ends consist of 6 arrows

Individual Match Play: All divisions at 25m, knock-out format, 12-arrow matches, 6-arrow ends

Team Match Play: All divisions at 25m, knock-out format

Recurve teams of 4: 24-arrow matches (2 ends of 3 arrows per archer)

Barebow teams of 2: 12-arrow matches (2 ends of 3 arrows per archer)

Compound teams of 2: 12-arrow matches (2 ends of 3 arrows per archer)

Teams

For the Team Match Play, a team consists of pre-selected archers <u>from one school</u> (four for recurve or two for barebow and compound), with an appointed captain and a manager. If space becomes limited, a cap may be placed on the number of entries from each school. Composite school teams are not permitted.

Attire

School sports uniform or school tracksuit. Closed in shoes.

Equipment

Unless otherwise stated, standard World Archery rules apply.

Archers using Genesis bows will compete in the following depending on their bow set up: no sight, finger release – Barebow; With a sight, finger release – Recurve; Use of any type of release aid – Compound.

Timing Lights will be used allowing 4 minutes per 6 arrow end.

Food

A fundraising sausage sizzle will be running through the event, selling sausages, burgers, baking and drinks. As the matches will be running alternatively through lunch time, we recommend that all archers bring lunch, or take advantage of the BBQ, as there may not be sufficient time to buy lunch elsewhere.

Safety

As we are situated in a busy public park, strict safety procedures must be adhered to. This information is included in the Shooting Protocol on the College Sport Auckland Archery Information page.

Scoring

Archers shall use approved scorecards with double scoring.

Archers should mark the target face with a pen to the side of each arrow after each end. This ensures that any bounce outs or pass throughs can be scored.

For team matchplay, no team should score their own arrows. When scoring, there should be 2 people from each team scoring on each target to ensure accuracy.

For Individual Matchplay, both archers should verify each other's scores before recording their own scoresheet.

It is the responsibility of all archers on the target to ensure that all scorecards are filled out accurately and signed on completion.
