TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

This tournament is aimed at the top/elite player.

Each school will be entitled to enter **two** boys and **two** girls in the singles, and two doubles pairings at both junior & senior level. Schools should hold championships or playoffs to decide upon their entries for this tournament. Singles players will not be allowed to play in the doubles competition. This is because of the problems that it creates with the draws. By not allowing Singles players to play in Doubles all of the competition should be finished before 3:00pm.

- Check in downstairs from 8.30am
- Managers Meeting scheduled for 8.45am (upstairs in committee room)
- Juniors/Seniors on separate sides
- Games are roll on/roll off

NOTE: To be eligible for nomination to the Young Sportsperson of the Year, top players must enter this tournament.

TOURNAMENT STRUCTURE

- Singles (Singles players are not allowed to play in the Doubles competition.)
- Doubles (There are NO MIXED doubles.)
- Format of games will be determined by entry numbers and will be confirmed prior to the competition.
- A Managers meeting will be held at 8.45am on the day of competition.

FEES

- You will be invoiced once entries have closed.
- Please note that teams withdrawn after the entry closing date will still be liable for the entry fee.

OFFICIALS

Players are asked to umpire their own games.

ELIGIBILITY

- Junior Year 9 & 10 and under 16 on 1st January 2024
- Senior Under 19 on 1st January in the year of competition (juniors can play up in senior grades).

TIME OF GAMES

PRIZES

- Medals will be awarded to 1st and 2nd place of each category.
- At Managers meeting decision regarding Prizegiving format to be confirmed.
