



Ultimate Division 1 Season Entry Information 2024

Dates and Times

Venues

- Home and Away school venues.
- Schools will need to be able to provide a marked field 25m x 70m (see field dimension diagram)

Divisions

- Open and Girls' divisions will be offered.
- Boys' teams and mixed teams will play in the open division.
- Where possible, coed schools are strongly encouraged to enter boys'/girls' teams. Mixed teams are possible if there are not enough players of each gender to make separate teams.

Entries

- Entries must be submitted via EnterNOW by 11.59pm, Thursday 8th February.
- College Sport will invoice schools once the season has begun.
- Teams withdrawing after the entry closing date will still be liable for the entry fee.

Team Management

- All teams must have a teacher or adult with them at every game. This person is to complete the score sheet before and after the game where needed, be aware of any medical problems of players in the team, implement the rules of the competition, and supervise the players. Teams without supervision may lose by default.

Officials

- Ultimate is a self-refereed sport. Calls on the field are resolved by the players involved.
- Spirit Captains or Coaches may enter the field of play to assist the resolution of a disputed call by helping explain a rule but cannot resolve the disputed call themselves.

Uniforms

- All members of teams participating in a College Sport competition must wear matching uniforms of their school appropriate to the sport.

Rules

The tournament will be played under standard World Flying Disc Federation rules of Ultimate with the following exceptions:

- **Field Size:** Schools Ultimate is played on a 5-a-side field 25m x 70m with 10m endzones inside this. A diagram is available on the College Sport website.
- **Team Size:** Schools Ultimate is played 5-a-side – there are 5 players per team on the field at once.
- **Substitutions:** Players may substitute between points as per the standard rules of Ultimate. Players may also substitute DURING a point. To substitute during a point, the player leaving the field must high-five the replacement player on the side-line at midfield. It is recommended that substitutions take place while the team is on offense so that you don't leave an opponent unmarked.
- **Pulls:** Players are encouraged to catch the pull when possible. Dropping the pull will not result in a turn-over. The pull cannot be advanced by hitting the disc forward instead of trying to catch it.
- **Stall Count:** For clarity – the stall count is 10 (as per normal rules of Ultimate)
- **Callahan's:** For clarity – Callahan goals are counted (as per the normal rules of Ultimate)

Equipment

- The home team shall provide a Discraft Ultrastar flying disc to be used as the game disc. Regulation discs can be purchased through Auckland Ultimate if needed.
- The home team shall provide 8 cones to mark the corners of the field and endzones and a scoreboard to keep the score.
- Hard-ground, molded football boots, or 'Cleats' are the recommended footwear. Running shoes are acceptable. Metal sprigged shoes are not permitted. Playing barefoot is not allowed due to health and safety reasons.
