### Eligibility

A player must be currently attending a College Sport school. Should a player leave school part way through the competition they will not be eligible to play from the day they leave school.

### Grade Descriptions

Premier and Reserve grades are offered on Wednesday at ABA Stadium, 99 Gillies Ave.

Boys and Girls Advanced and Social grades are offered Monday to Friday.

Boys grades can be boys, girls or mixed teams.

Grades are ranked as:

Premier	- Boys and Girls	Any school year	*schools top team
Reserve	- Boys and Girls	Any school year	*formerly A Grade
Advanced	- Boys, Girls and Open	Any school year	*formerly B/C Grade
Social	- Boys, Girls and Open	Any school Year	*formerly C/D Grade

- Players playing in a higher grade in Term 2 cannot play in a lower grade in Term 3

### Entries

- Teams consist of a maximum of 6 players.
- Entries must be submitted online via Enter NOW by 11.59pm 28<sup>th</sup> March
- Entries received after the entry closing date may be accepted at the discretion of College Sport. Late entry fees will apply.
- Please note teams may have to travel to alternative venue if original venue cannot accommodate all teams
- Schools may be offered an alternative venue/day/grade if there aren't enough team entries in a grade
- **First one or two teams entered by schools will be added to the draw the rest will be added only if court space allows and there are spaces for more entries**

### Team Registration

- Team lists must be submitted online via Enter NOW by 11.59pm on 4<sup>th</sup> April

### Team Management

**All teams must have a teacher or adult with them at every game.** This person is to complete the score sheet before and after the game where needed, be aware of any medical problems of players in the team, implement the rules of the competition, and supervise the players. Teams without supervision may lose by default

### Fees

- As per Enter Now
- College Sport will invoice schools once the season has begun.
- Teams withdrawn after the entry closing date will still be liable for the entry fee.

### Uniforms

- Court mats are at the facilities and only non-marking clean shoes or bare feet are permitted.
- All members of teams participating in a College Sport Competition must wear matching uniforms of their school appropriate to the participating sport.
