



Auckland Senior Volleyball Championships Entry Information 2024

Date

Wednesday 13 March – 15 March

Venue

Pulman Park, Walters Road, Takanini

Age Groups

Under 19 on 1 January in the year of competition

Entries

- This tournament is open to any teams from schools within the area administered by College Sport Auckland.
- 2nd teams will be put on a waiting list, depending on availability.
- Entry Fee as per EnterNow
- Entries must be submitted online via EnterNOW by 11.59pm 28 February.
- No late entries will be accepted.

Officials

- **Compulsory meeting** for all Coaches and Managers for all participating teams on Monday 11 March 2024 at 7.00pm via zoom
- Students ID need to be sent to margaret@collegesport.co.nz by the 6 March 2024.
- Schools are to nominate their 2nd referee, endorsed (as competent) by the appropriate volleyball association or zone coordinator.
- First referees will be supplied, ***note you will still need to provide a scorer, 2nd referee and one line referee for your own games (OWN DUTY). The exception to this is the top 8 quarterfinals, semifinals and finals which will have a rostered duty.***
- Schools need to nominate a staff member or other responsible adult to supervise the team at all times.
- Schools will be invoiced after their team entries have closed.
- Please note that teams withdrawn after the entry closing date may still be liable for the entry fee.
- Entries will not be accepted from schools with outstanding Volleyball debts unless payment of these debts is made by the entry closing date.

Team Registration

- Team lists must be submitted online via EnterNOW by 11.59pm 6 March 2024
- A maximum of 12 players may be registered in one team.
- Photo IDs in colour and with DOBs to be sent to College Sport by 6 March 2024

Playing Format

- Each match will be best-of-three sets until the quarter finals (top 8) onwards as best-of-five (sets to 25 and deciding set of 15, each with a minimum 2-point advantage).
- Roll-On, Roll-Off will be used to keep matches on schedule. Between each match there will be a maximum of 10 minutes duration from the time the preceding match ends to the first serve of the subsequent match.

Draws

Draft draw once completed will be put onto the College Sport website to view.

If necessary once amendments have been made from compulsory meeting the confirmed draw will be updated online.

Draws will be available at the venue throughout the tournament using the QR code displayed, this will be updated after each round.

Rules

All rules included in the FIVB Official Volleyball Rules 2021-2024 will be in use apart from:

- 12 substitutions and a libero player will be allowed.
- Team Managers must produce Student ID when requested before playing by officials.
- Seeding for National Championships will be decided from this competition, excluding North Harbour schools.
- Any teams who default on finals day put their school in jeopardy of participating in this event next year.

Uniforms

- Team uniforms must be of school uniform style and colour. Playing shirts must be numbered on both the front and back. Teams risk forfeiting matches for incorrect uniform. Libero shirt must be a different colour than other players shirts.
