



## Cycling Points Race Competition Information 2024

### Date

Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> June 2024, Pukekohe Park

### Entries & Eligibility

- Entries must be submitted in EnterNOW by 11.59pm, Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> May 2024.
- Teams withdrawn after the entries closing date may be liable for the entry fees.
- By entering any College Sport Auckland competition schools give permission for College Sport Auckland to use images taken at events/competitions on the College Sport website and social media platforms.

### Age Groups

- U13, U14, U15, U16, U17, U19 girls and boys (as at 1 Jan 2024)  
Races may be combined based on entry numbers
- Entries of teams of 3 are encouraged. Road racing is a team game, working together to achieve the best team result.
- Teams can be any 3 of the same grades (do not have to be the same school)
- Teams formed at the start are fixed for the series
- Team points are the sum of individual points
- Each team are to make up their name
- There is no additional cost for entering a team
- Team awards will be given at the end of race 3 for team results

### Race Start

- First race will start at 8am
- The racetrack will open for practice from 7:15am to 7:45am

### Registration

- The TIC in charge must collect their schools race pack from the registration desk which will be open from 6.30am. They will need to make sure the students are given the correct transponder – numbers will be assigned to each student.
- Please make sure all Marshall's (except spotters) check in with College Sport staff and collect clipboard and high vis vest by 7:30am, to be out on track at 7:50am.

### Rules

- National school gearing applies: 6.61m up to U16, 7.0m for U17, 7.93m for U19
- Points are awarded for sprint laps and for the final lap.

Medals will be awarded at the Team Time Trial (TTT) finals day (Please note date change: 18<sup>th</sup> August 2024)

**Uniforms**

All riders should be wearing their school riding kit

**Team Management**

All schools must have a teacher or adult with them. This person is to be aware of any medical problems of riders, implement the rules of the race, and supervise the riders. Riders without supervision may be withdrawn from race.
