A few reminders for **Sunday 7 April** below.

- Very important
 - All <u>climbers & belayers</u> need to complete the online waiver prior to climbing day - climbers, belayers - thursday. This is an event specific waiver so even if you climb/belay there every day, you need to complete it.

- Car Parking Out on the street, unless you are a very early volunteer and grab a park outside the gym.
- Score Desk
 - On top of the boulder: For any scoring disputes/queries (within 5 mins of official posting of results on the noticeboard)
- Schools Sports/ PE top

- Must be worn, see Rock Climbing Handbook, climbers have been sent home to get changed in previous rounds. Year 11-13 students please allow time to loan one from your Sports department if you do not have one.
- Finalists we encourage any potential finalists to read over the Rules & especially Finals rules in our Rock Climbing Handbook in advance.
- Online scoring system We have an online scoring system for entering your final scores. A cell phone and data is needed, if this is not possible, please come to the score desk.
- Score Sheets
 Please keep your SCORE SHEETS & hand them in at the Spot Prize Desk
- Smashed Potatoes food truck will be in the carpark, and it has eftpos.
- Volunteers are needed to put up & take down the markers from the walls.
 Putting up on friday 5th April at TBA, (you could get assessed for belaying at the same time). Taking down on sunday while senior spot prizes is on approx 12pm. Please register with us for friday night helping.
 - For both bring any of the following if you have, & your climbers are welcome to come drill, harness/belay belt, climbing shoes.
- Auckland Sport Climbing Club (ASC) committee members are needed. We
 have 1 online meeting a year, everything else is done by email. It's not a big
 workload as that is covered already, but we need fresh idea's & opinions.

All belayers without climbers competing eg teachers, climbing coaches need to complete this belayer link.

THE COMPLETED SURVEY is a requirement for your climbers entry to be accepted

This needs to be completed by 28 Mar or ASAP

& if you need a belayer exemption complete the belayer survey and choose that box.

- We need people to man the AUTOBELAYS, no belay experience required. This might suit those who haven't belayed before or are injured. Please email us ASAP.
- Belayers/ Autobelayers <u>PLEASE read the</u> attached link
 Belayer role & Policy before the event.
- Please see below times for belayers briefing
 - Belayers briefing time: (which is compulsory to attend)
 - o 7.55am for belayers of Year 9-10 climbers
 - o 9.25am for belayers of year 11-13 climbers
 - **Belayers Sign In Desk** for junior belayers in the climbing gym area, for senior belayers under the arch/overhang on the lead wall.
 - Schools entering more than 1 student a 1 belayer per 2 climber ratio applies. Larger schools 12+, a 1 to 3 ratio applies.
 - **Never top rope belayed before:** To get signed off for the first time contact the gym to make a time. It takes approximately 30 mins & take a climber with you. This cannot be done on the competition morning.
 - No sign off's on the day unless it has been oked by Sandra. We have a
 very small allocation allowed to be signed off on the day by Extreme
 Edge, please let us know NOW if you need this.
 - Any Junior parents that are likely to be staying for the finals, we would really appreciate it if you could help out and do a turn on the seniors belaying, please email me ASAP. I would allocate you to a quiet climb.
 - Any Senior Students 16 years and above that are signed off for Extreme Edge and can come early & belay for 30-60 mins, please let us know, that will be incredibly helpful.

- The senior climber (yr 11-13) would climb at the juniors climbing time, but scoring would go into the senior round.
- The senior climber would attend the junior spot prize draw.
- It cannot be v/v (juniors climbing in the senior round) as placings have been announced
- All times are a guideline only, nothing will be earlier but there maybe delays on the day.

- **11.30am** Climbing finishes Senior round Qualifying area now available to the public
- **11.30am** Spot prizes Senior climbers
- 11.30am Volunteers needed to belay & climb to remove the markers, bring a harness/belay belt & drill if you have it, otherwise we will have extra's. This will happen while senior prize giving is on, so only judges are unavailable. Look for the awesome volunteer in the pink high vis vest Jo.
- **12.00pm** Finalists announced everyone else free to leave (or stay & watch the finals).
- 12:00pm All finalists (senior & junior) go into isolation in the cave
- **12:05pm** Judges viewing, followed by finalists briefing with judges then viewing
- **12.30pm** Finals commence 2 divisions on wall at a time, 1 climb per division.
- **1.40pm** Finals completed
- **1.50pm** Prizegiving
- 2.00pm Round 1 complete
