Championship Information

- These championships are for students who are enrolled full time in a secondary school that is a member of College Sport.
- All players must be members of a club affiliated to NZ Golf
- Start tee time will be between 7.30am – 9am with 7- or 8-minute intervals.

Qualification

Under 19 as at 1 January of the current year.

- Male: official handicap of 15 or less
- Female: official handicap of 24 or less
- The field will be **limited to a maximum of 120 players**. The top 90 boys will be accepted based on a handicap of 15 or less and the top 30 girls on a handicap of 24 or less, providing that if the allocated number is not reached, it will be given to other entrants.
- **College Sport Young Sportsperson of the Year Awards** – students that wish to be nominated for the annual awards in November, ***must compete in this event***.

Entry

- Your Entry must be completed online by 11.59pm **Thursday 9 May and Thursday 30 May**
No entries will be accepted after this date.
- Entries will not be accepted on the day for Health & Safety reasons.
- Entries will not be accepted if competitors do not have Principal's approval.
- Entries will not be accepted from schools with outstanding Golf debts unless payment of these debts is made by the entry closing date.

Fees

- You will be invoiced to schools' once entries have closed.

Rules and Regulations – Strokeplay & Teams

- The rules shall be those of the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews, and those local rules of the host club as may be necessary.
- Golf wear must be worn with school shirt.
- No caddies.
- Distance measuring devices only
- No electronic gadgets including smartphones
- No smoking or vaping
- Clothing: please wear an appropriate shirt top that identifies your school. **No jeans, tracksuits or beachwear.**
- All cards must be handed in immediately after the finish of each round.
- The decision of the Tournament Committee on all points and disputes shall be final and binding.
- If a tie, count back rules are adhered to.

Teams Competition Rules & Regulations (New in 2023)

The two winning Auckland schools and one North Harbour school (based on golfs boundaries) will qualify teams for the NZSS final.

- Includes both strokeplay events – 36 Holes
- School must name their teams when doing online entry – maximum 4 players, minimum 3 players.
- Top 3 Gross scores count
- Schools are unable to change teams from one strokeplay event to the other.

Prizegiving

Will be held at second event. Final 18 Holes.

- Prize giving will be at approximately 2.30pm and must be attended by all players.
- Awards include: _ strokeplay
 - 1st, 2nd, 3rd male 36-hole gross 1st, 2nd, 3rd male 36 hole net
 - 1st, 2nd, 3rd female 36-hole gross 1st, 2nd, 3rd female 36 hole net
 - Overall Teams 36-holes gross 1st
