



Gymsports Championships Entry Information 2024

Date & Venue

The College Sport Auckland Gymsports Championships for Artistic, Rhythmic, Trampoline & Tumbling will be held on Thursday 13 June 2024 at Pulman Recreation Centre, Takanini.

Entries

- Entries must be submitted in [EnterNOW](#) by 11.59pm Thursday 30 May 2024.
- **Students cannot enter themselves directly. All entries MUST be submitted by the school in EnterNOW. No late entries or replacements will be accepted on the day.**
- It is the school's responsibility to ensure their entries are correct. Entry confirmation can be downloaded from EnterNOW.
- Students may compete in any number of disciplines (Artistic, Rhythmic, Tumbling and/or Trampoline). The organisers will try to allow for this in their programme as much as possible. Students will need notify the relevant officials on the day if they are competing in multiple disciplines.
- College Sport Auckland will invoice schools after the event.
- Students withdrawn after the entries closing date will still be liable for the entry fee.

Eligibility

- Refer to College Sport Auckland [Bylaw 4](#) – General Eligibility
- Year 7 & 8 students may only compete if their school has opted to pay College Sport Auckland Year 7 & 8 levies.

Team Management

- Competitors must have an appointed teacher or adult accompany them on the day. This person's details must be submitted in EnterNOW. Entries with 'TBC' will not be accepted.
- This person needs to be aware of any medical problems of their competitors, implement the rules of the competition, and supervise competitors. Those without supervision may be ineligible.
- A compulsory managers meeting will be held at 8.15am.
- College Sport Auckland will have a first responder attending the competition. However, team managers should also take their own first aid kit.

Officials

Each school must provide a volunteer official. Their details must be submitted in EnterNOW by the entries closing date.

Timetables

- The compulsory managers meeting will start at 8.15am.
- The competition will run from approximately 8.30am – 3.00pm.
- Full timetables will be published on the College Sport Auckland [website](#) and app.
- Prizegiving ceremonies will take place throughout the day.

For artistic gymnastics, medals will be awarded to the top three individuals in each grade. Certificates will be awarded to teams in Women's Levels 1, 2 & 3 and Men's D Grade. Teams may consist of three or four students from the same school who are competing in the same grade. The best three scores on each apparatus/routine will be totaled for the team score. Schools with six or more students in any of these grades must email their teams lists to College Sport Auckland by Thursday 30 May 2024.
