Playing rules of the game All matches are governed by FIFA laws of Football APC Knock out games

All games must have a result; draws are not accepted. In the event of a draw, there will be a 5-minute break followed by extra time of 10 minutes each way. There will be no break between the extra halves. In the event that there is still no result, the match will be decided on a penalty shoot-out if still drawn after 5 penalties the game goes to suddendeath penalties, where each team takes a further one penalty each, repeated until only one team scores, resulting in the winning of the game.

If a draw is recorded on the results sheet, College Sport in conjunction with the CEO will then make the decision with a toss of a coin.

In APC Round 1 & 2 the home team will (where possible) be given the home ground advantage. For all other rounds, home ground advantage will be based on field availability and previous travel distance and number of home games in previous APC rounds (the season rounds scheduling does not have any influence on the APC allocations).

APC Finals are played on artificial turf. There will be a short prizegiving immediately after the games
