



Lacrosse Girls One Day Championships Entry Information 2024

Times

Games will be played from 10.15am. A meeting will be held at 9.45am, and all managers must attend before games start. Prize giving will be held at approximately 2.30pm

Entries

Entries and team lists must be submitted online via [EnterNOW](#) by **11.59pm Monday 12th August**

Team players must be under 19 on the 1st January 2024 as per the College Sport Auckland Bylaws. The squad size can be a maximum of 18 players. A maximum of 10 players can be on the field at any one time.

Team Management

All teams must have a teacher or adult with them at every game. This person is to complete the score sheet before and after the game where needed, be aware of any medical problems of players in the team, implement the rules of the competition, and supervise the players. Teams without supervision may lose by default. Although St Johns staff will be in attendance, schools should have with them basic first aid.

Fees

- Refer to EnterNOW for entry fee
- College Sport Auckland will invoice schools after entries have closed
- Teams withdrawn after the entry closing date will still be liable for the entry fee

Duties

All teams are expected to bring an umpire. School umpires will be paid \$10.00 per game from College Sport Auckland. Schools will need to send College Sport Auckland an invoice after the tournament stating number of games officiated. This will need to be sent through by Monday 26th August. If you are unable to provide an umpire, please contact Auckland Lacrosse on admin@aucklandlacrosse.co.nz who may be able to help provide one for you. The cost of an Auckland Lacrosse umpire is \$50.00 for the day, and this will be paid directly to Auckland Lacrosse.

All schools are to provide at least one goal for the tournament. Some schools may be required to bring more than one depending on the number of fields available.

Rules

A copy of the Rules & Regulations is published in the Lacrosse Girls Handbook which is also posted on the College Sport Auckland website and app. The policy on withdrawals, defaults, and rescheduled matches, is also available online and on the app.

Uniforms

- All players must play in the school's recognised playing uniform with numbers
- Any team not deemed to be in correct uniform risk defaulting their game
- Eye goggles/protection and shoes are compulsory
