Equipment & Uniform

- All players must wear non-marking footwear.
- All players must wear same colour playing shirt, except for the goalkeeper who must wear a different coloured shirt or bib.
- Shin pads with socks high enough to cover shin pads are required.

Game Duration

40-minute blocks

- 2x16-minute halves
- 3-minutes half time break
- 5-minutes between games

Laws of the Game

Number of Players & Substitutions

- 5 players are on the court at one time (including goalkeeper).
- Substitutions are unlimited “flying” substitutions.
- Players can re-enter the game from their own bench without notifying the referee.
- A substitute cannot enter the court until the player coming off has left the court.
- The referee must be notified if the goalkeeper is changed.

Start of Play

- From a kick-off, the ball is in play once it is kicked and moves in any direction. The opposing team must be outside the centre circle.

Out of Play

- Ball is placed on the sideline or the corner. Ball must be stationary and kicked into the court.
- Players have 4 seconds to kick the ball into play.
- All opposing players must be at least 5 metres from the ball.
- A goal cannot be scored directly from a kick-in unless it touches another player.
- The non-kicking foot can be anywhere (there are no foot fouls during kick-ins)
- The entire ball must be over the line for it to be out-of-bounds or a goal.

Team Management

All teams must have a teacher or adult with them at every game. This person is to complete the score sheet before and after the game where needed, be aware of any medical problems of players in the team, implement the rules of the competition, and supervise the players. Teams without supervision may lose by default. Photo IDs must be available at all games.

Entries

- Entries must be submitted online via EnterNOW on 18 September 2024 11:59pm.
- College Sport will invoice schools once the season has begun.
- Teams withdrawn after the entry closing date may still be liable for the entry fee.
- Late entries may not be accepted.
