

DRAW EXPLANATION/OVERVIEW

The College Sport Auckland Junior Volleyball Champs has a draw of 48 teams. The teams start in the main draw with 16 pools of 3. After the first round of pool play, teams are split into 3 divisions.

Division 1 (finishing 1st in pool on day one) & **division 2** (finishing 2nd in pool on day 1) play for all 3 days (Wednesday, Thursday and Friday).

Division 3 (finishing 3rd in pool on day one) will compete for just two days (Wednesday and Thursday). On day one division three teams will have an extra game (Round of 16) and on day two they will play quarterfinals, semi-finals and finals.

RULES & REGULATIONS IN BRIEF

(Please refer to full version on the website)

Playing Format

- Each match will be best-of-three sets (sets to 25 and deciding set of 15, each with a minimum 2-point advantage)
- Roll-On, Roll-Off will be used in order to keep matches on schedule. Between each match there will be a maximum of 10 minutes duration from the time the preceding match ends to the first serve of the subsequent match.
- 1 minute per set for warm up (3 minutes net time total per team)

However, court controllers may use **their discretion** to decide appropriate intervals in **extraordinary cases**, with consultation with the tournament director.

Duty/Referees

- 1st referee will be provided for all games.
- Day One: Duty will be rostered in pools, 1st referee supplied.
- Day Two: Duty will be 'own' duty with 1st referee supplied.
- Day Three: Division 1 Top 8 quarter, semis and finals this will be (LPG) Loser Previous Game please check the draw for this.
- Own duty 2nd referee, scorer and 2 lines people will be required between both teams to do duty. (E.g. 2nd referee team A, scorers 1 from A and B, linesmen 2 from team B)

Tournament Rules

All rules included in the FIVB Official Volleyball Rules will be in use with the exception of:

- 12 substitutions instead of 6 per set.
- **NO** libero player will used in this junior competition.
- The player's bench is only for those named on the sheet.
- Teams will lose the first set if more than 15 minutes late, warm up or net time is forfeited. Game will start straight away.
- If teams turn up later than 30 minutes after the start time the game will be defaulted.

Uniforms

- Must be of uniform style and colour.
- Playing shirts must be numbered on both the front and back.
- Shorts **MUST** be the same. All tights or all shorts.
- Playing barefoot is also not permitted. Shoes must be worn.

*Teams risk forfeiting matches for incorrect uniform.

Players must meet these criteria as determined by VNZ for this junior competition. These are that they must be:

• Year 9 or Year 10 only, and under 15 on the 1st of January 2024.

A maximum of 12 players may be registered in one team.

Please note that players may be replaced in your official team registration up until the beginning of the team's first match the morning of day one, prior to the tournament). After this time, no players may be added.

Any changes to team lists and shirt numbers <u>must be handed in to the Venue Controller before your</u> <u>first game</u>. All queries regarding player eligibility will be subject to verification from College Sport.

Match Ball

Schools are to provide their own match balls. (Official Mikasa Balls).

Tournament Team

There will be a tournament team chosen this will be announced at Prizegiving.

Rules for Pulman Trust Arena

- No music through foyer
- No bouncing of balls in foyer these will be confiscated.
- All teams to be upstairs unless playing or doing duty.
- No food or drink permitted inside court area.
- Only **NON-MARKING** court shoes are to be worn on the court.
- No Chewing gum is permitted anywhere inside the Pulman Arena Building.
- Clean up your section of rubbish when your team leaves.
